***Songs for the Hall* – Wednesday 13th May 2020**

In May 2020 Wilton's Music Hall will present a festival of emerging music talent, which will feature: opera & classical; contemporary & jazz; popular, rock & indie; urban, electronic & DJ; cabaret.

We are also presenting a School Choir Day – Songs for the Hall.

We are looking for young people from Tower Hamlets and East London to fill our Hall with song for the day. Children and teachers will gather together to sing through a selection of songs chosen by the Wilton's Songs for the Hall Curator, Steve Pretty (musician and founder of the Hackney Colliery Band). Children will be able to learn the songs in school before presenting them on Wednesday 13th May 2020.

If your school has a group of pupils or an existing choir that would like to apply to take part then please fill out our application form attached. We are accepting applications from all Tower Hamlets, Hackney and Newham state-funded schools (local authority maintained, academy or free school) and all ages and stages.

Songs for the Hall will be presented in association with Snape Maltings' Friday Afternoons, with free vocal leadership training for all teachers involved. www.fridayafternoonsmusic.co.uk

What will taking part involve?

Learning up to three songs chosen by us and three songs chosen by you in advance of Wednesday 13th May 2020.

If chosen, coming to Wilton's on Wednesday 13th May 2020 and performing on the Hall stage.

There will be two sessions with four schools performing in each session, eight schools in total.

Schools may only bring a maximum of 30 people (teachers and young people). Sessions will take place at the following times: 11.00 – 12.00 and 13.30 – 14.30. Schools will be able to watch other schools perform within their time slot.
